The Intel International Science & Engineering Fair (Intel ISEF) is the world's largest pre-college celebration of science. Held annually in May, the Intel ISEF brings together over 1,400 students from more than 50 nations to compete for scholarships, tuition grants, internships, scientific field trips and the grand prize, a \$50,000 college scholarship. You'll meet new friends, speak with Nobel Laureates and see the sights of an exciting city.

As a participant of the Pittsburgh Regional Science & Engineering Fair (PRSEF), you may submit an application to attend the Intel ISEF.

**GET INVOLVED!** To be considered for Intel ISEF, you must be registered as a Pittsburgh Regional Science & Engineering Fair participant, submit a Preliminary ISEF Student Application Form along with one copy of your research paper and email your research paper to [prsef@carnegiesciencecenter.org](mailto:prsef@carnegiesciencecenter.org) by Monday, February 12, 2010. Judges review these papers prior to PRSEF. Selected students will be interviewed on Fair Day. Final selection will be determined by a panel of judges at an interview session in the afternoon of Fair Day. Winners will be announced during the Awards Ceremony on Saturday, March 27, 2010. Winners must be available on Tuesday, March 30 for final paperwork submission to ISEF.
